【Fuji-Q Highland Rules for Coming with a Dog】

※At check-in, we'll verify that you've brought dog-walk rinse water (in a PET bottle) and poop bags. Please be sure to bring them.

※If you agree to the rules, please check the check box.

Terms and Agreements	Check Box
1. Dogs can enter the park and ride the Ferris wheel, Teacups, and the "Risa & Gaspard Carousel" only if their shoulder height is 50 cm or less.	
2. Always keep your dog on a leash held by an adult. The leash must be a store-bought leash, up to 2 meters long. No handmade leashes.	
3. If you use a flexible (stretch) leash, lock it so it does not go longer than 2 meters.	
4. You must bring a poop bag. If you do not have one, you cannot enter. Clean up your dog's poop and take it home. If your dog marks (pees), pour water from your bottle to wash it away. Bring a bottle of water for marking checks at the entrance.	
5. Please do not place dogs on benches or other park surfaces, as these are used by the public.	
6. Dogs without rabies shots and mixed vaccines cannot enter. Dogs with infectious diseases also cannot enter.	
7. If your dog hurts someone or causes an accident, the park is not responsible. If your dog breaks something, you may have to pay for it.	
8. Dogs cannot enter shops, restaurants, toilets, indoor places, and the Central Park grass area. You may pass through Shop Fujiyama only with a pet cart or by carrying your dog. You cannot shop with your dog. Thomas Land allows dogs only if the whole body is covered in a pet cart, etc.	
9. If you eat with your dog, use terrace seats or take-out food.	
10. Do not leave your dog with staff or other guests, even for a short time.	
11. Please be kind to guests who are afraid of dogs or have allergies. Be careful around vehicles.	
12. Before you enter indoor places (shops, restaurants, toilets, free indoor rest areas), shake off dog hair from your clothes. Use hand sanitizer if it is there.	
13. Do not brush your dog inside the park.	
14. If your dog's condition is not good at the entrance, you may not be allowed to enter.	
15. Make sure your dog does not scare or bother other guests.	
16. If there is a problem or accident in the park, the park is not responsible. If dogs have a problem or accident, the owners must talk and solve it themselves. In the event of a "biting incident", the pet owner should contact the public health center.	

If you break the rules, you may be asked to leave. No refunds for 1-day passes or ride tickets.
